About College and Hospital :

Visionary and staunch admirer of Indian culture and heritage, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel motivated Vaidya Sunderlal Joshi, a freedom fighter and Ayurvedic physician to start an institution in Nadiad as a part of freedom struggle with patriotic motive of encouraging education and health care in Ayurveda through an institutional system. The J.S.Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya (including Ayurveda Hospital, which was later on named as P. D. Patel Ayurveda Hospital) in Nadiad, the oldest in Gujarat, was established in 1938. This institute and its professional and non-professional staff worked hard in the direction of fulfilling his dream. As a result of a steady and continuous pace of progress, this institute attained a global status, known for its standard education, notable success in the management of chronic illnesses including various serious diseases like chronic renal failure etc.

In the year 2007, the institute has taken a bold decision to switch over from a grant-in-aid to a Self-Finance Institute (SFI) to accelerate the pace of development. The institute became SFI on 1st September, 2007. Svanirbhara Divasa is celebrated every year in September, first week. Presently the college is conducting BAMS course with an intake capacity of 100 students per year and PG in five subjects.

J.S.Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya & P.D.Patel Ayurveda Hospital, Nadiad are managed by Mahagujarat Medical Society, a charitable non-government organization, established in Nadiad. The society is engaged in health care and health education in this part of the country, which manages two specialty hospitals in cardiology and oncology along with a general hospital and one Nursing College, besides this institute.

5th International Conference on "Rediscovering the Scopes for Ayurvedic Pediatrics"

JS Ayurveda college, Nadiad was established in 1938, and was grant-in-aid institute for several years. About 12 years ago the Mahagujarat Medical Society (MMS) realized the potential of the faculty of the JS Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya (JSAM) and it became self-financed in 2007. This enabled the faculty to work independently toward one goal in unison and that is to develop professionally and progress in the field of Ayurveda health system. Since then the college and hospital have made significant progress in education and patient care. The teamwork done by Team JS (entire staff of JSAM) proved very well beyond the expectation. So the management decided to celebrate its independence as Svanirbhara Divas. This might sound maverick to many, but we were and are simultaneously pragmatic also. We know that we need active support and cooperation of entire Ayurveda fraternity towards developing Ayurveda to meet the present-day health challenges. In order to share our professional experience, accept and respect others' new experiences, and also to facilitate exchange of knowledge and experience among professionals of India and abroad the college started organizing International conferences since 2015 and along with it pre-conference workshops since 2016.

Till about a couple of decades ago children were considered to be little adults as far as their health conditions, care and treatment were concerned. This is true for any system of medicine. As a result, the approach and treatment plan adopted for children were most of the time designed for the adult patients. However, with more and more research being devoted for the pediatric population exponential variations in response to drugs started unfolding. Similarly, anatomical and physiological variations at different ages from birth till adulthood also influence the pathological processes and response to treatment. There are several such factors that make pediatrics a challenging subject. Many educational institutes are working excellently in this field, but the complacency has no place in the present time for the betterment of this branch of Ayurveda. There is a greater need to exchange the knowledge, disseminate it and further enhance it for the welfare of the ultimate beneficiary. So the next international conference going to be held between 30th August to 2nd September, 2019 is related to the field of pediatrics. This includes a two-day workshop on Ayurvedic pediatrics. The theme of this conference is "REDISCOVERING THE SCOPES OF AYURVEDIC PEDIATRICS".

The goals are very lucid. Covering each and every aspect of Ayurvedic pediatrics starting from preconceptional and embryonic period to modern life style disorders including addiction to internet, video games, etc is our aim. So JSAM has decided to broaden the scope of the conference and included a wide range of subthemes. This will enable any Ayurveda research scholar, practitioner or faculty working in any field to participate in this conference.

JSAM cordially invites you to actively participate in this upcoming international conference and join hands with us to effectively proliferate and enhance the field of ayurvedic pediatrics.

Instructions to Participants :

- ★ The paper should not have been presented or published before anywhere.
- ★ Code of sub theme should be mentioned on right corner of the title page of paper.
- ★ Title page should contain Title of paper, Full name of authors with designation, Institute's name, Postal address, Email ID and Contact numbers.
- ★ Paper should be in IMRaD Format.
- ★ Case study and case series should be as per the CARE criteria. Title should include case study/case report/case series. In case study and case series there should be follow up of the case/s. In case study there should not be the section of conclusion.
- ★ Referencing should be according to Vancouver style of referencing.
- ★ Tables, charts, diagrams and images should be in the end after references.
- ★ Do not add references in the footer. Give appropriate numbers in the text for the references (in the superscript).
- ★ Do not capitalize and italicize ayurvedic terms. For capitalization and italicization please follow English grammar rules.
- ★ Spelling should be according to American English.
- ★ No decoration in the article is accepted. It should be neatly computer - typed (MS word) on A-4 sized paper, preferably not exceeding 5-6 pages.
- ★ It should be either in English or Hindi (KrutiDev045 font). Please don't mix two languages in one sentence, and in one paragraph.
- ★ Shlokas, if any, may be typed in KrutiDev045 font, and complete references should be given. (KrutiDev045 font is placed on Website for ready reference)
- ★ Abstract and incomplete papers will not be considered.
- ★ Authors need to send a hard copy of full paper with signature at the bottom of each page along with a certificate (A facsimile copy of Certificate is available on the website of the institute (www.nadiadayurveda.org)).

- ★ Paper should be sent by email in MS Word to Email Id : js.int.2019@gmail.com
- ★ Selected papers can be considered for oral or poster presentations.
- ★ Selected papers can be considered for printing in the souvenir to be released at the time of inauguration and distributed among delegates.
